Dr Eckart von Hirschhausen (born 1967) studied medicine and science journalism in Berlin, London and Heidelberg. His speciality: communicating medical content in a humorous way. He gives lasting impulses that stick: on television, as a non-fiction author, at congresses or as a keynote speaker.
